



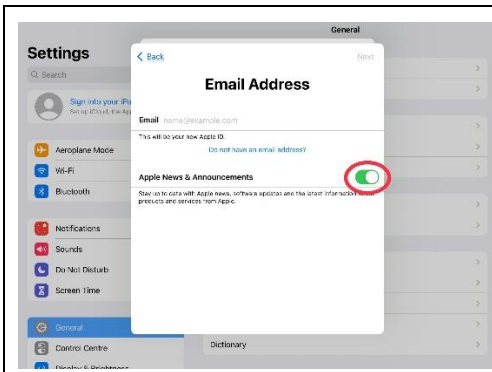


Set up a NEW APPLE ID

An **Apple ID** is the account you use to access Apple services, such as the App Store to download apps. You need an email address, a password and payment details – a credit card, a debit card or Paypal. Adults need an Apple ID to set up Family Sharing for their children under 13 years of age.

	<p>Enter your name and birth date details</p>

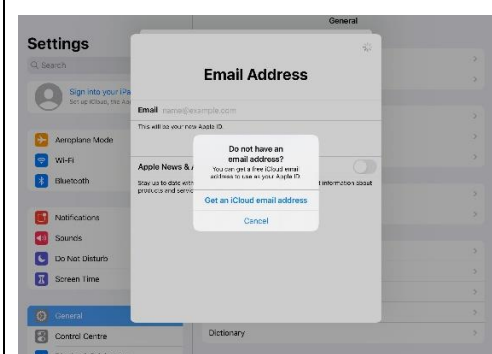


You need an email address to use as your Apple ID.

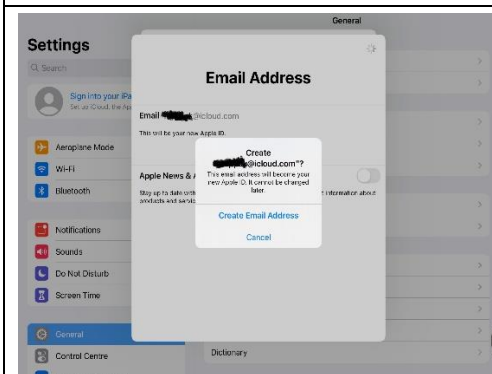
If you already have one, you can enter it straight away.

If not, you have the option to create an *@icloud.com* email address.

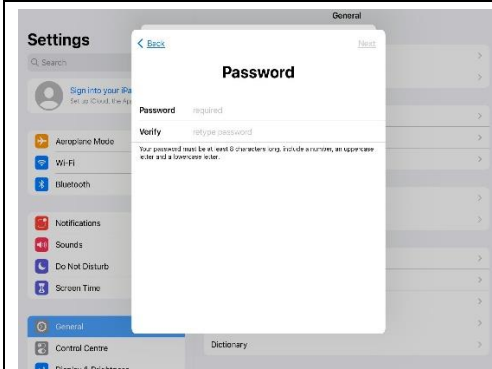
Decide whether you want to receive Apple News & Announcements emailed to you. If not, turn it off.



NB You will see this screen only if you decided to create an iCloud email address above.



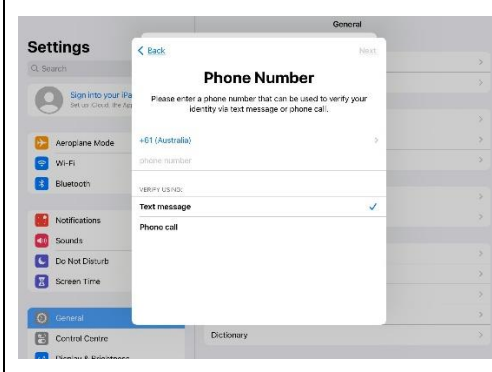

Choose a password.

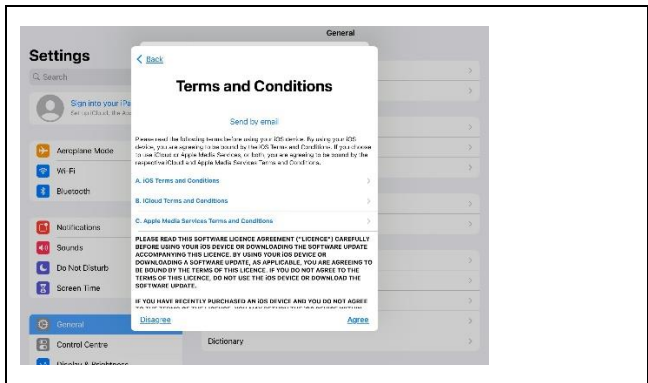
It must be at least 8 characters long, include at least one number, uppercase letter and lowercase letter.

Record your password and keep it in a safe place.



Your phone number is needed so that you can receive either a text message or a phone call to verify your identity when you use your account.

Select whether you want to receive a text or a call for this.



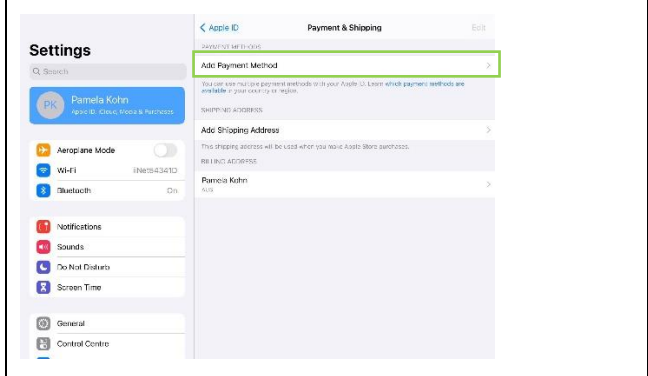
Agree to the terms and conditions.

You have the option to have them emailed to you or to read them on the screen.



Choose whether you want to be able to merge your iCloud calendar, internet data, messages and contacts so they are available on all devices that you sign in to with your Apple ID.

If you choose to merge, you should create an account for your child using Family Sharing once you have your own Apple ID (see How to Set Up Family Sharing). It is preferable that you are not signed into the device your child will take to school.



The last step is to Add Payment Method.

You can use Credit or Debit Card or PayPal.
